Classification for Spring Show.

The Committee went into the question of the classification for the Spring Show & sale of Bulls for 1941, and agreed that the classes for Shorthorns, & Double Dairy Beef and Non-Pedigree Bulls of the Shorthorn type, it being, however, agreed to extend the date of birth of one of the Non-Pedigree Bulls to 30th June, instead of 31st May. In the classes for Aberdeen-Angus Bulls, it was agreed that two of the classes be for bulls calved between 1st February 1939, and 15th March, 1939, inclusive and (b) Bull calved after 15th March.

Classes for British Friesian Bulls, Figs & Stallions were also allowed to remain the same as last year, and the Secretary was directed to communicate with the Department of Agriculture, asking if they would be prepared to present the prizes, if a special class was put on for Irish Draught Stallions.
