Paper read by Dr. J. C. Saunders.

~~Dr.~~ Dr. J. C. Saunders, City Medical Officer of Health, read a paper to the Committee on the "Uses of Town Waste", on which there was a short discussion. Mr. A. H. Moore moved that the best thanks of the Society be tendered to Dr. Saunders for his paper, and this was seconded by Mr. E. Wall. In associating himself with the vote, Professor Boyle said an important subject - like "Town Waste" - should not be allowed to be passed over without further investigation, and he suggested that the matter be taken up at a future Meeting of the Society for discussion, and, if necessary, to invite the City Manager. Dr. Saunders, in replying, thanked the Members for their vote of thanks, and he suggested that another Meeting should be held, but that instead of the City Manager, the City Engineer should be invited, as he was in charge of the Electric Cars used for gathering the waste of the City. It was agreed that the matter should again be discussed at a future Meeting.
