Comparative figures for 1941/42.

The President, in reviewing the financial position for the year, gave comparative figures for the years 1941 & 1942. The nett loss on the year was £273. 11. 1, as compared with £450 : 0 : 11 for 1941.

Report & Statement of Accounts.
