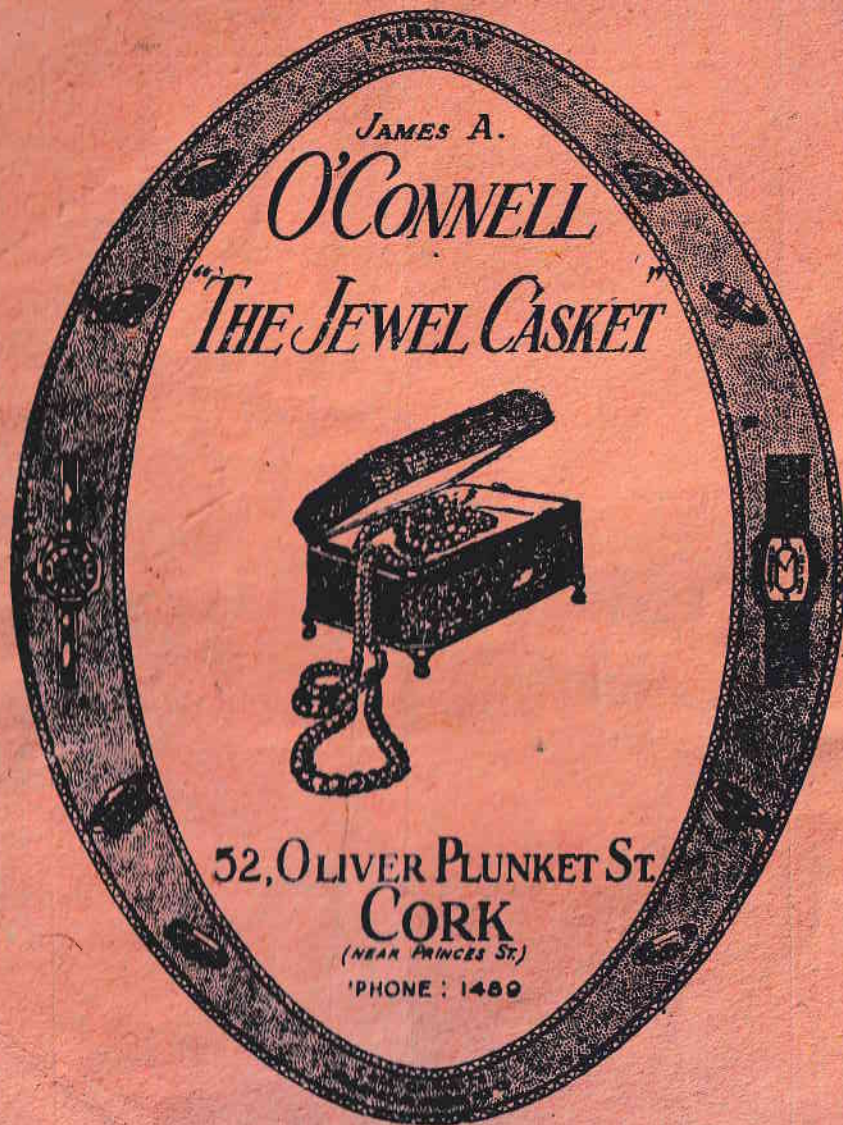

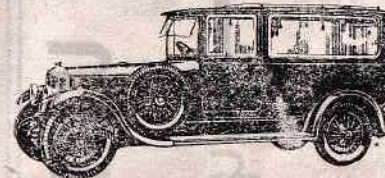

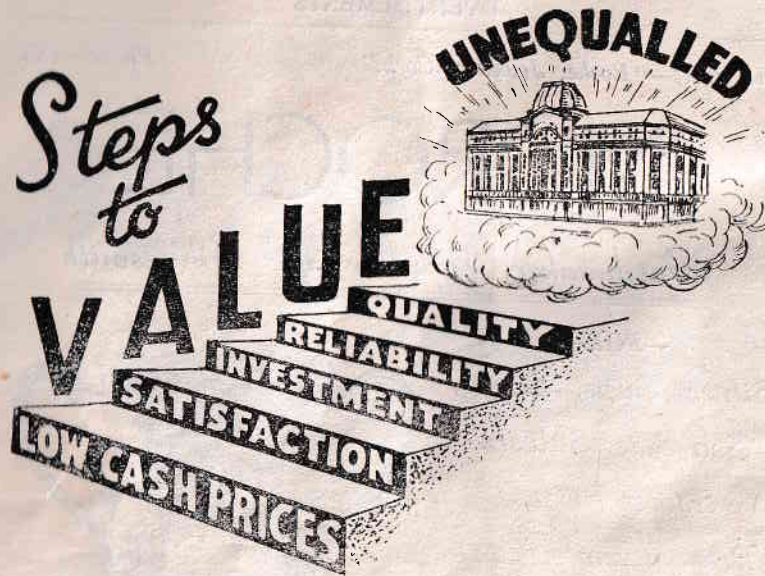

The Society reserves the right of altering the time and conditions of competition for any of those Cups for future Shows, or of withholding a Cup if the Judges do not find sufficient merit.

- (1) **CHALLENGE CUP.**
Presented to the Society.
For the best Three-year-Old Hunter Gelding. To be won three times not necessarily in succession. Won in 1944 by James Barry.
- (2) **BAINBRIDGE CHALLENGE CUP. Value £15.**
Presented by Mrs. Bainbridge, Elfordleigh, Plympton, Devon.
For the best three-year-old Filly. (See Class 8). To be won three times, not necessarily in succession.
- (3) **THE O'SHEA CUP.**
Presented by the late Sir Henry O'Shea.
For the best Yearling or two-year-old in the Hunter Classes. To be won three times, not necessarily in succession.
- (4) **BARRY GEORGE MEMORIAL CUP.**
To be competed for every year in perpetuity. For the Best Hunter Brood Mare in the Show. Won in 1944 by John J. Barry with Turkish Dancer.
- (5) **BREEDERS' CHALLENGE CUP.**
Presented to the Munster Agricultural Society by Mr. N. Hayes and the Late Mr. A. Morrison.
For the best four-year-old Hunter, Gelding or Filly, bred by exhibitor. To be won three times, not necessarily in succession. Won in 1944 by James Barry with "Baritone".
- (6) Prizes in Class 14 presented by an anonymous donor.

CATTLE.

(7) **MAXWELL GUMBLETON CHALLENGE CUP.**

To be competed for every year in perpetuity. For the Best Shorthorn in the Show of any age or sex. The winner's name and year of winning to be engraved on the Cup.

(8) **THE "SUTOL" PERPETUAL CHALLENGE CUP.**

Presented by Messrs. Suttons Ltd., Cork for the best Group of Non-Pedigree Registered Cows from any one Branch of the Irish Dairy Shorthorn Breeders' Society in Munster. Won in 1944 by Cork Branch.

(9) **The sum of £130 has been jointly contributed by the Co. Cork Committee of Agriculture and the Department of Agriculture towards the Cork Spring and Summer Shows.**

£40 in Prizes presented by the Department of Agriculture in the following Classes:—

(10) **Towards the Prizes in Classes 17, 19, 20 and 21. No prize will be awarded in these Classes unless there are at least three Competitors. 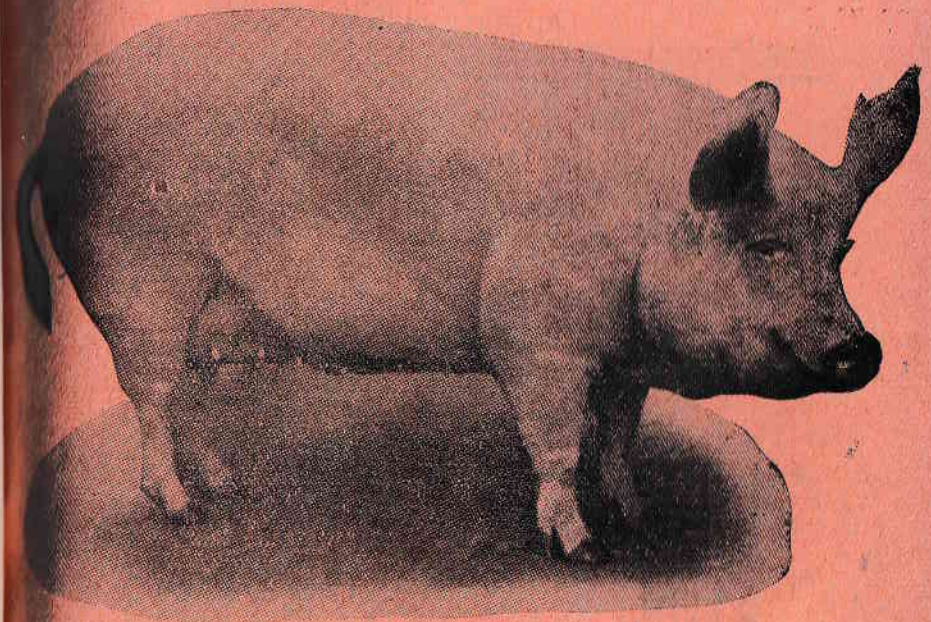
