

Re-election of President:

On the motion of Mr. E. Wall, seconded by Mr. M. Ryan, Mr. E. J. Clarke was unanimously re-elected President. In returning thanks, and declaring himself re-elected, it was, he said, his sixteenth year of office, and he took his re-election as a very great honour to himself, and also a vote of confidence to the Committee, which had worked so hard for the Society.

Recommendation:
