The Minutes of the last Annual General Meeting were read and signed.

Annual Report & Statement of A/c's.

The Secretary read the Annual Report for the year 1952.

The President (Mr. E.J. Clarke) said, in the course of his address, that the Balance Sheet and Statement of Accounts had been in the hands of the members for some time, and, before moving their adoption, he would go into some of the figures:--

The General receipts under the heads of Rents Receivable and Subscriptions, have increased £2,335. On the other side of our General Expenses, which include the expenditure on repair and upkeep, have increased by £3,029. Of this increase, materials and wages account for £2,524. The balance of the increase is due to higher cost of rents and insurance, bank interest, salaries, income tax, electric light and power and depreciation.

The Show & Sale of Bulls left us a profit of £441, against £447 the previous year. The total receipts for the three days Cork Summer Show were £7,654, against £6,334 for last year's two-days Show, and left us a profit of £4,375, against £3,500 - a satisfactory outcome of what was something of an experiment. The nett profit for the year was £569.

The President then moved the adoption of the Report and Statement of Accounts, which was seconded by Mr. N. Hayes, and passed.
