

The following is a detailed statement of alterations made for this year's Prize List -

That the Catalogue be drawn up in accordance with the system used by the Dublin Society, and only classes be quoted.

The silver cup presented by Mr Dring is for the best pony from 12 to 14 hands high drawn in harness. The whole turn out to be taken into consideration.

Class C. Section 3. to be omitted.

Class F Section 1 to be read = For the best gelding or mare from 14 to 15 hands
Section 2. = to be read = For the best gelding or mare from 12 to 14 hands
Section 3. to be read = For the best gelding or mare not exceeding 12. hands.

In class G. to be introduced prizes for the best hood mare in foal to or with foal at foot by a thoroughbred horse, which in the opinion of the judges is best calculated to produce high class weight carrying hunters. and which is the property of a bona fide tenant farmer whose poor law valuation is under £100.

First prize £7 - second prize £3. entry fees 15 members 5/- and non members 10/-

Jumping Prizes.

First day - Special jumping class for horses which are not entered in any class of the show, catch weights. 1st prize £7. 2nd prize £3. entry 10/-
The second and third days to be similar to the first and second days of last year.

Class D. Longwooled sheep. additional prizes to be offered for the best pen of 5 - Ewe lambs £3.
